#### **Operable Unit Carbon Tetrachloride Plume (OU CTP)**

Discussed drilling progress and difficulties with equipment at one location. Should finish up all drilling by end of March. Tracer test will be repeated due to marginal aspects of tracer detection rendering it inconclusive.

# **Operable Unit 2 Landfill Gas**

Discussed vent requirements and design. EPA originally requested vents, which, except for sampling, have normally been closed. No pressure buildup has been measured. Discussed ultimate operation of system currently being defined through a pilot study. Final system will be fully documented in the next O&M manual; could consider this phase a fine-tuning phase to determine optimum configuration for final implementation.

#### **Ambient Air monitoring**

Regulatory, 5% fence-line, methane limit is being met. Army inquired about cutting back on soil gas monitoring – as ambient air VOC monitoring would duplicate risk monitoring requirements. Reviewed handout.

# **Groundwater Treatment Systems**

reviewed handouts. Discussed approaches to extending operational change (vinyl chloride discharge limit) for one more year. The Army will modify last field work variance submitted in February 2002 with minor changes and a brief discussion on the increased efficiency of the system using the modified discharge limit.

# **Operable Unit 1 Pilot Study**

The Pilot Study is in progress with the next monitoring event scheduled for Jan 13-15, 2003.

The Army received comments from regulatory agencies; responses in preparation
