OU 1 Groundwater Remediation – Shaw

The Army sampled the offsite monitoring wells on 5/22/07. Preliminary results will be available in July.

Operable Unit 2 (OU2) and Sites 2/12 Treatment Systems

OU2 – The system operated with an average flow of 766 gallons per minute in May. Key events were described in a handout.

Sites 2/12 – The system operated at 217 gallons per minute in May. Key events were described in a handout.

Operable Unit Carbon Tetrachloride Plume (OUCTP) Record of Decision (ROD) and Pilot Study

ROD – Discussed additional changes to the ROD text to address soil gas. Final language on this was agreed upon at the meeting. The latest revision will be submitted next week.

Pilot Study – The Army received comments from DTSC on the pilot study work plan. The Army will provide responses within 30 days. Drilling started in early June, after receipt of a decision by U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service regarding the recent discovery of a California Tiger Salamander pond within two kilometers of the pilot study site.

Other Groundwater Issues

Groundwater Sampling - The quarterly sampling started June 18, 2007. MW-BW-25-180 was vandalized and obstructed with pieces of concrete. The well may need to be abandoned. The BCT agreed that there are no comments to the Draft Report of Quarterly Monitoring, Jan - Mar 2006 and the Army can issue the draft final version.

University Village – Four replacement monitoring wells were installed and will be sampled during the June sampling event. The pipeline between the treatment plant and Sites 2/12 is being rerouted. The existing pipeline will continue to be used until the new line is completed.

East Garrison – Four underground storage tanks were encountered during grading for development at the East Garrison. All four were removed and properly closed in accordance with county regulations.

Groundwater Treatment System Optimization

OU2 – The electrical power has been connected to extraction well EW-08 and it will be ready to start operation next week.

OU2 Landfill Gas

Graphs of methane concentration from extraction wells, and the treatment system were distributed and discussed. The treatment system is presently operating on a cycle of four weeks on and two weeks off. The Army is evaluating the addition of gas extraction wells in Area D. The additional methane from Area D would allow the treatment system to operate continuously.

Basewide Range Assessment

The Army will address DTSC comments to the *Draft Final Comprehensive Basewide Range Assessment Report, Former Fort Ord, California, and Revision 1C* after receipt of comments to Site 39 reports.

Site 39 Ecological Risk Work

The draft final report was submitted 4/30/07. DTSC requested an extension of the review period until 6/20/07.

Site 39 Feasibility Study (FS) Addendum

The draft report was submitted May 31, 2007. Comments are due 7/10/07.

Site 3 Post Remediation Monitoring

A draft letter report was issued 4/30/07. Comments are due 7/6/07.

FFA Schedules

No changes were made to the schedules.

FOST/FOSL/FOSET

FOSET 5 – Issue of MEC as a hazardous substance has been addressed and FOSET 5 will be issued for public comment next week.

FOST 10 – Awaiting the EPA concurrence letters.

Five Year Review

The draft was issued 3/31/07. The Army and EPA met to address comments on 6/21/07. DTSC submitted comments to the HTW sections of the report and deferred to EPA for the MEC sections of the report.

Range 36A

The Closure Certification Report has been submitted for Army signature.

Open House/ July Community Involvement Workshop (CIW)

The Open House will be June 23rd at the Shaw complex.

The July CIW topics are the OU2 Landfill and the ESCA.
