Operable Unit 1 (OU 1) Groundwater Remediation – HydroGeoLogic (HGL)

OU 1 Off-Site

The treatment system and extraction well EW-OU1-93-A have been operating continuously since 4/7/09. Monitoring wells will continue to be sampled monthly until June. The April sampling was completed 4/14/09. The system influent was 4.2 ppb for TCE on 4/14/09 and decreased to 2.5 ppb on 5/5/09. Monitoring wells were all non-detect on 4/14/09. The Army will evaluate pulse pumping the treatment system. The EPA requested that the Army issue a tech memo if pulse pumping is proposed. A handout was provided.

Operable Unit 2 (OU2) and Sites 2/12 Treatment Systems

OU2 – The system operated with an average flow of 610 gallons per minute (gpm) in April 2009.

Sites 2/12 –The system operated with an average flow of 208 gpm in April 2009.

Other Groundwater Issues

Groundwater Sampling – The June sampling is scheduled to start 6/15/09. The Draft Annual Report of Quarterly Monitoring October 2007 through September 2008 was submitted 5/6/09. The quarterly sampling report for Dec 2008 will be issued next week. Fort Ord contractors are awaiting access to the Geotracker database to upload reports for the RWQCB.

EPA requested that the Army and contractors limit the use of overnight deliveries when possible to reduce project costs.

Operable Unit Carbon Tetrachloride Plume (OUCTP) Remedial Action

Well vault and pipeline installation was completed in Preston Park on 3/17/09. The Draft EISB Pilot Study Report was submitted 3/19/09. Received comments from DTSC. RWQCB has no comments and EPA is reviewing the report.

Shaw sent draft responses to DTSC comments to the RD/RA work plan. DTSC sent comments to the responses. Discussed plume stability and conceptual site model. A possible meeting in Sacramento to discuss DTSC comments was also discussed.

GW Treatment System Optimization

The Draft Final Technical Memorandum, Groundwater Remediation Exit Strategy, Sites 2 and 12 and OU2 will be submitted in late-May.

OU2 Landfill Gas

The TTU system is operating four days per week. Methane is at 40%. Data is available on the Shaw Portal. A handout was provided.

Basewide Range Assessment

The Interim Action Approval Memo for site HA-161 has been approved and the public notification was placed in two local papers on 5/8/09.

The Draft Final No Action Approval Memos for Sites HA-79, HA-92, HA-98, HA-100, HA-121 and HA-183 were submitted to the public and the notification was placed in two local papers.

The public comment period is 5/18/09 to 6/17/09.

Site 39 Record of Decision (ROD) Amendment

Army HQ's and EPA reviews for the Final Site 39 ROD amendment is in progress.

The Army has addressed U.S. Army Center for Health Promotion and Preventive Medicine (USACHPPM) and Army legal comments. The Army will issue redline /strikeout and accepted versions of the updated ROD Amendment by the end of May.

FFA Schedules

It was agreed upon to change the final Site 39 ROD Amendment signature date to July, 2009.

FOST/FOSL/FOSET

FOSET 5 –The 3,300 acres included in FOSET 5 have been transferred to FORA.
