## **OU-1 Groundwater Monitoring and Treatment Plant Operations**

Remediation is complete. The northwest treatment system (NWTS) is offline but operable. The 2G alarm system is not operable. The remediation system was inspected on 30 May and was observed to be in good condition. Carbon samples were collected for profile analysis in advance of removing the carbon for regeneration or disposal next month. Analytical results are expected before 16 June.

## **Reporting/Federal Facility Agreement Schedule**

The status of ongoing and anticipated reports for OU-1 is summarized in Table 1. The Draft Work Plan and related APP/SSHP for the upcoming well destruction effort were submitted for regulatory and public review. Comments are due by 26 June.

#### **OU-1 Rare Plant Monitoring**

The BRAC Office submitted the 2016 Rare Plant Survey Report to the USFWS and CDFW. The baseline rare plant survey at the wells to be destroyed and the third-year survey at the sites monitored after the 2014 well destruction effort have been completed and results are being processed. HGL will present the results of the baseline and third year post destruction survey results in the same report.

#### **OU-1** Closeout

The Draft Work Plan to destroy the remaining OU-1 wells and decommission the NWTS is in agency review. Field work is targeted to begin the week of 10 July if the agencies concur that work can begin after responses to comments on the Draft Work Plan are accepted.

#### **OU-1 Five Year Review**

The regulatory agencies recently provided comments on the Draft Five Year Review report.

#### **Other Topics**

- The BRAC Office / Army / Regulatory Agencies discussion on the possibility of a partial delisting from the Fort Ord Superfund site for OU-1 will remain on hold for the near future.
- HGL will place plastic bags or mesh around well caps to deny entry to bees if any activity is observed during the next site inspection.

- There was some discussion concerning potential for revisiting OU-1 in the future regarding perflurooctanoic acid (PFOA) and/or perfluorooctane sulfonate (PFOS). It was agreed that OU-1 status could be revisited at any time if there are changes in regulatory standards for PFOA/PFOS at the State or Federal level. EPA indicated they were not aware of any pending regulatory changes. Because of the risk uncertainties posed by PFOA and PFOS, EPA requested in their comments on the Five-Year Review Report that the Army carry over OU-1 into the 5<sup>th</sup> Five-Year Report due in 2022.
- Next BCT is 1330 PCT on Friday 14 July with Community Involvement Workshop on Saturday.
- Upcoming BCT meetings are Wednesday 09 August and Wednesday 13 September.

## **OU-1 Action Items:**

• Submit draft and final minutes for previous BCT meeting(s)—Final minutes through May 2017 have been uploaded. The draft May minutes were approved as written.
