OU-1 Groundwater Monitoring and Treatment Plant Operations

The former northwest treatment system (NWTS) site was inspected for the last time on 31 August 2017. No unusual conditions were observed at the former treatment site except for broken neutral service on the PG&E power pole. HGL reported that problem to PG&E on 05 September 2017 and PG&E notified us by text that they repaired it the same day.

Reporting/Federal Facility Agreement Schedule

The status of ongoing and anticipated reports for OU-1 is summarized in Table 1. The proposed Closeout Report is a primary document and will be submitted by 18 September 2017. The submittal schedule is presented in Table 1. The Well Destruction and NWTS Decommissioning Report will be included as an Appendix in the Closeout Report.

OU-1 Rare Plant Monitoring

The BRAC Office submitted the 2016 Rare Plant Survey Report to the USFWS and CDFW. The biological monitoring and habitat report for the 2017 baseline rare plant survey at the destroyed wells and the third-year survey at the sites monitored after the 2014 well destruction effort is being prepared for Army review. Monterey spineflower populations were widespread and abundant in comparison

to past results. The area along the northwest boundary road encompassing most of the OU-1 wells fell within population polygons; only isolated plants were observed in this area in the past.

Other Topics

- The BRAC Office / Army / Regulatory Agencies discussion on the possibility of a partial delisting from the Fort Ord Superfund site for OU-1 will remain on hold for the near future.
- Upcoming BCT meetings are 13 September and 11 October. All meetings are on Wednesdays at 1330 PCT.
- Maeve Clancy will be out from January April 2018. EPA will identify a temporary replacement.
