#### **Property Transfer Status:**

The Army provided:

- FOSET 5: All deeds have been forwarded to FORA for signature.
- FOST 10: All draft deeds are complete except for York School. Two deeds have been finalized, MOCO and City of Marina, and have been forwarded to FORA for signature.

**ESCA Update:** FORA described participation in the Monterey County Fair project outreach booth August 16 and plans to provide an update at the October Community Involvement Workshop. Appendix K of the Technical Information Paper for the cleanup of the SCAs in Seaside parcels was distributed to all members and interested parties.

#### **Fieldwork Update**:

### MEC Fieldwork:

E20c.1 Investigation Area: Using graphics describing Test Plot Locations and Proposed Targets, the Army described plans to conduct additional investigation to increase the understanding of the site.

#### **Prescribed Burn Preparations:**

- Units 2 and 3: Army reported that preparations for a prescribed burn in 2008 are complete with the exception of some pending interior roadway reinforcement. DTSC initiated a discussion concerning the origin of the base rock used to improve fuel break roadways in vicinity of MRS-BLM Units 2/3. The origin was described by the Army as a quarry in the vicinity of Aromas, CA.
- Units 18 and 22: Army presented the status of prescribed burning preparations in the designated units. All preparations are complete.
- Community Notification: No Discussion
- Air Monitoring: Right-of-Entry documentation for all air monitoring sites have been completed.

#### **Site Security Program:**

- Trespass Incidents: None.
- MEC Incidents: None.
- DTSC asked for, and Army provided, a description of the final disposition of danger signs on the impact area fence being relocated to accommodate FORA construction.

## Track 3 Impact Area Munitions Response Area (MRA):

The draft RD/RAWP by USACE will be issued by the end of August. The BCT approved the proposed schedule for the RD/RA program. The BCT approved the subject to be an agenda item at the October CIW.

Track 2 - Parker Flats MRA: EPA indicated that they are in the process of signing the ROD.

**Track 2 DRO MRA**: The Army reported the ROD remains under review by the Department of the Army legal office. The BCT agreed to delay the FFA schedule by one month.

**Report Status:** The Army provided that the draft final work plan for units 18-22 will be published this week.

**FFA Schedule**: The BCT agreed to move the MRS-16 AAR to October 31.
