Community Relations: Army provided an update on community relations actions:

- 1. EPA's technical assistance needs assessment community meeting is scheduled for the evening of April 10.
- 2. Planned community relations actions include a guided walk in the Impact Area on May 11, partnering with BLM in the Fort Ord National Monument one year anniversary celebration. Community Involvement Workshop featuring bus tours is scheduled for July 13, and Technical Review Committee meeting on July 16.
- 3. The Army is updating the agency and public document distribution list.

Property Transfer: The Army provided an update to current property transfer actions:

- 1. **FOST 11:** Fort Ord BRAC will work with EPA to develop text that would address EPA comments.
- 2. **FOST 12:** The Army is preparing deeds for the properties.
- 3. **FOSET 4 deed amendment:** USACE review of the deed amendment is in progress.

- 4. **Parcel L20.4 (Oil Well Rd) transfer to BLM**: Transfer assembly package is nearly complete. OMB waiver for the no-cost transfer is pending.
- 5. **RCRA corrective action completion determination**: DTSC is working with FORA and jurisdictions to address the issue with comfort letters. The Army will revise the site boundary subject to the RCRA permit.

ESCA Update: FORA provided a verbal ESCA program update and a handout summarizing technical and community outreach efforts from the previous month.

Prescribed Burn Program: Unit 10 remains prepared for a prescribed burn as soon as the burn season begins on July 1. The Army described that Unit 7 will also be prepared for burning during the 2013 season. Unit 7 site preparation requirements will be described in an update to the prescribed burn plan. Biological monitoring in Unit 7 (baseline) and other areas will begin next week.

Fieldwork Update: The Army provided an update on recent and planned fieldwork:

- 1. A map identifying the locations of significant (potentially influential on future cleanup activities) surface MEC finds during recent remediation activities was provided.
- 2. Subsurface removal in 100-ft buffer within Unit 4 began this week.
- 3. Fieldwork in the 100-ft buffer around the MOUT Site is complete. Work in Phase C fuel break grids has been occurring intermittently.
- 4. The totals for UXO items and MD (lbs.) processed in active remediation units/areas to date were provided.
- 5. Tracking of MEC work: DGM is continuing in prescribed burn containment lines and expanded vegetation cut areas under the SSWP Units 6, 7, and 10. DGM in Units 10 containment line is in progress.
- 6. A detonation was conducted on April 3.
- 7. Site 39 information: At HA-37, soil excavation is complete. Post-remediation MEC removal will begin next week. High anomaly density is expected in J-grids

MMRP Safety and Site Security: There were no incidents during the previous month.

Remaining RI/FS Areas: The Army provided an update to the production of an RI/FS for the remaining areas. For the area north of the Impact Area, an overview presentation was provided to the MR BCT in March. A separate meeting with MR BCT and BLM has been scheduled for April 17.

MRS-34 (FAAF):

The Army had provided an updated text of the Proposed Plan for DTSC review in February. A subsequent DTSC comment letter was received. Draft final Proposed Plan will be issued in April for regulatory agency review. A 30-day public comment period may be scheduled for June.

Report Status: The Army provided a review and update:

- 1. MRS-BLM Units 4, 11, and 12 (2011 units) technical memorandum was issued on March 22. The Army will respond to EPA comments. DTSC comment is pending.
- 2. MRS-BLM Units 15, 21, 32 and 34 (2010 units) remedial action report is scheduled for final.
- 3. Track 2 MRS-34 (FAAF) draft final Proposed Plan will be issued by 13 April.

FFA Schedule: The Army provided a review of the FFA schedule. There were no changes.

Action Items: The Army provided a description of action items due and pending. A summary of February TRC meeting has been finalized noting that FORA will respond to an information request under separate cover.

The next meeting of the MR BCT was scheduled for May 8 at 10:00 A.M. and June 12 at 10:00 A.M.
