Community Relations: Army provided an update on community relations actions:

- 1. The Army conducted a cleanup tour for the community group Sustainable Seaside with 45 participants.
- 2. Army will staff a cleanup information booth at the Monterey County Fair on August 30.
- 3. Army will provide agencies with a new draft of a response to comments submitted by Fort Ord Community Advisory Group.
- 4. BLM provided a summary of public comments during a public meeting concerning access to BLM lands in north Fort Ord. The relationship of BLM with Fort Ord National Monument support groups was discussed.

Property Transfer: The Army provided an update to current property transfer actions:

- 1. **FOST 11:** EPA agreed to revision of language on July 29. Army has requested that EPA and DTSC withdraw non-concurrence comments.
- 2. **FOST 12:** A conference call between HQ-OC, SPK OC and BRAC-FO on July 25 discussed deed requirements. SPK-OC is subsequently finalizing the deed.
- 3. FOSET 4 deed correction: No change.
- 4. **Parcel L20.4 (Oil Well Rd) transfer to BLM**: USACE HQ sent changes tracked letter of transfer back to SPK-RE requesting changes be accepted and list of enclosures be updated. SPK-RE sent letter of transfer back to USACE HQ on august 3.
- 5. **RCRA corrective action completion determination**: FORA will meet with Fort Ord jurisdictions on September 18 concerning "comfort letter" approach to informing property owners of termination of corrective action.

ESCA Update: FORA provided a verbal ESCA program update and a handout summarizing technical and community outreach efforts from the previous month. Some additional RQA work is continuing in the Seaside 1 parcel.

Prescribed Burn Program: The Army described the status of preparation activities for a prescribed burn in 2013 season.

- 1. The availability of suppression helicopters is questionable due to draw for wildfires burning in California and other states.
- 2. Two blackout events (Laguna Seca) remain in the current burn season. August 10 and 16-17 are blacked out (no prescribed burn).

Fieldwork Update: The Army provided an update on recent and planned fieldwork:

- 1. A map identifying the locations of significant (potentially influential on future cleanup activities) surface MEC finds during recent remediation activities was provided.
- 2. Vegetation cutting in the 100-ft buffer of Units 5A and 9 is complete. A 100-ft buffer subsurface removal in Unit 6, 1, 2, 3 is in progress. Adjacent property owners and municipalities have been advised.
- 3. The totals for UXO items and MD (lbs.) processed in active remediation units/areas to date were provided.
- 4. Surface MEC removal in Unit 7 containment line is complete.
- 5. DGM is complete in prescribed burn expanded vegetation cut areas under the SSWP for Units 6, 3, and 2.
- 6. No detonations have been conducted since April 3.
- 7. Vegetation cutting in the unburned areas of Watkins Gate Burn Area began late July.

MMRP Safety and Site Security: The Army provides a description of recent MEC and trespass incidents, community education events and related training.

1. There was 1 MEC incident reported since the July 15 meeting.

- July 31 BLM staff reported discovery of a suspected MEC item in Unit 21. A response by MEC safety contractor personnel identified the discovery as 2 2.36" practice rockets, expended.
- 2. The Annual Track 3 Surface Monitoring Report (2013) is scheduled for publication in September. A summary will be presented to the MR BCT at the September meeting.

Remaining RI/FS Areas: The Army provided an update on the status of the development of an RI/FS for the MRSs and adjoining property outside the impact area. Draft RI/FS for BLM Area B is in preparation.

MRS-34 (FAAF): The Army provided an update on the status of a ROD. The Track 2 ROD MRS-34 (FAAF) was issued on August 2.

Report Status: The Army provided a review and update:

- 1. The FWV of SSWP for Non-Burn Areas to provide for the subsurface MEC removal in the 100-ft buffer (south) of BLM HQ was published on July 18.
- 2. The draft Track 2 RI/FS for BLM Area B is scheduled for issue on September 2.
- 3. Draft SSWP for the unburned areas of Watkins Gate Burn Area was issued July 30.

FFA Schedule: The Army provided a review of the FFA schedule. Draft revised schedule for the Track 3 program was reviewed and approved by the BCT.

Action Items: No action items were described as due or pending.

The next meetings of the MR BCT were scheduled for August 6 at 10:00 A.M. and September 11 at 10:00 A.M.
